After you initially register, whether you select the in-person or virtual option, you can change your registration choice without penalty until January 14, 2022.

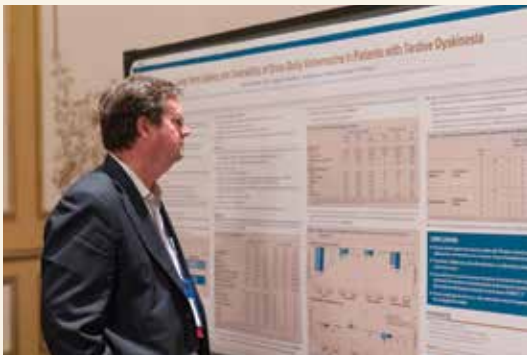

and abroad, as well as a wide range of exhibitors showcasing leading products and services.

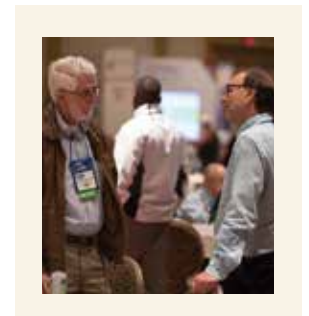
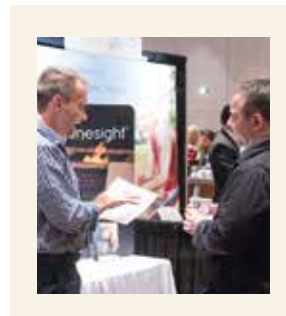
The conference is presented by the Nevada Psychiatric Association, an official district branch of the American Psychiatric Association.
